The Solon Community pool located at 35000 Portz Parkway was a fast track project. This project consisted of a new dehumidification unit for the indoor pool along with the addition of a new ultraviolet light system for water filtration. We had only had 6 weeks to complete this project, however we completed this project in just under 4 weeks. The equipment supplied was a 50-ton Seresco pool dehumidifier, 2 Lochinvar Boilers, 1 ultraviolet light and added air distribution above the pool. A poor-performing indoor pool environment HVAC system can deteriorate structural steel, electrical panels, and cause serious mold epidemic throughout the space. This project came in under budget and met all the expectations of the client.
